

## MISSION MINISTRY

**Street Reach:** Assist in cooking evening meal and serving the homeless at the Street Reach facility on Wednesday evenings.

**Grace Luncheons:** Help cook and serve monthly luncheons for the homeless of Myrtle Beach. Every 2nd Sunday of the month, September through December. Lunch served in the Fellowship Hall.



**Mobile Meals:** The mission of Mobile Meals is to provide a balanced meal five days a week to those in our area who, for whatever reason, cannot provide for themselves. Volunteers from FPC help deliver the meals at certain times of the year.

**Habitat for Humanity:** Habitat builds decent, affordable homes for those in need with the help of volunteers and the homeowner families. Need volunteers to work on the job site doing various construction duties. No experience necessary.

**Local and foreign missions:** Participate in local and foreign mission opportunities to build homes, repair and restoration of damaged homes, etc.

## OFFICE SUPPORT

**Office Assistant:** On an "as needed" basis to answer phones and greet visitors to the church.

**Newsletters:** Join the Newsletter Team to stuff and prepare newsletters for mailing.

**Newsletter/Pew Angels:** Place newsletters in the Sanctuary pews or straighten and replenish supplies in pews (Thurs. or Friday)

**FPC Love Boat:** Fill Love Boat bags with material for each member family or serve as a First Mate. (Annual Stewardship drive)



## ADULT EDUCATION

**FPC Library Assistant:** Help maintain library at Kings campus; occasional clerical duties.

**Book Club Leaders:** Needed not only to recommend a book, but to lead a discussion at book club meetings.



**Sunday School/Bible Study:** Need teachers to facilitate Sunday School classes and leaders for various small group Bible Study classes meeting throughout the year.

It is important that we be engaged in ministry that fulfills each of our needs for involvement and commitment. You are encouraged to consider what you are good at doing or what you enjoy doing in choosing your area of service.*

# Opportunities...

## WORSHIP

**Communion:** Prepare Communion table with wine & bread prior to worship service and clean up following service.

**Usher:** Hand out worship orders, seat people and collect offering. Ushers needed for worship on Sundays (serve one full month per year), Thursdays and during funerals.



**Greeter:** Welcome people as they enter the church. Serve one full month per year (Sundays)

**Early Sabbath Hospitality:** Hostess and clean up refreshment area in the narthex on Thursdays.

**Recorder:** Following Sunday worship, stand next to minister and record member's concerns, names & addresses of visitors, etc. Serve one full month per year.

**Flowers:** Arrange flowers for Sunday worship (no experience needed—will train); also need flower delivery volunteers to homebound members and local nursing homes (Monday AM)

**Silver Kings/Queens:** Polish Communion silver, candelabras, collection plates, etc.

## MUSIC/SPECIAL ARTS

**Adult Chancel Choir/Soloists:** Needed for Sunday worship services. Weekly rehearsals on Wednesday PM.

**Chancel Ringers:** Adult handbell choir made up of coordinated musicians who enjoy making music. Weekly rehearsals on Tuesday PM.

**Instrumentalists:** Needed for Sunday morning and Thursday evening services on an "as needed" basis throughout the year.

**Acting/Dance:** On an "as needed" basis for occasional services or performances.

**Set Design/Costumes/Makeup:** On an "as needed" basis for occasional performances.

**Children's Choir/Handbell Helpers:** Assist with children September through March.



## CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES

**LOGOS:** Friends and mentors to children grades 1-5: Table Hosts, Bible Leaders, Crafts Teachers, Game Leaders, Comfort Keepers, etc. Wednesdays, September—March

**Sunday School Teachers/Assts:** For children 2 years old through 5th grade. Full curriculum with detailed, yet flexible, lesson plans provided. Opportunities to serve vary from once a month to one month a year or full term.

**Children's Church Leaders:** Detailed lesson plans provided for leading little worshippers 4 years old through 2nd grade. Once per quarter.

**Nursery:** Help our professional staff nurture our babies in the nursery. During regular Sunday and Thursday services or special church events including Christmas Eve.

**Vacation Bible School:** Teachers and guides needed for one week in June, 8:30 AM until noon. Help with Bible time, crafts, games, snacks, decorations and more!



## YOUTH MINISTRY

**Impact Group Leaders:** Lead small group based on age and gender. Weekly meetings focus on building community and creating a time of fellowship in addition to devotion and Bible study. Impact groups frequently participate in other fellowship opportunities as a group.



**BIG Meeting Leaders:** BIG Meeting meets on Sunday evenings during the school year. Separate meeting times for Middle School and High School students.

## CONGREGATIONAL CARE

**Visit the sick and elderly.** Take a meal or simply visit and chat.

**Transportation.** Drive members with mobility issues to church or store or medical appointment.

**Health Education.** Do you have an area of expertise that would benefit the congregation? We need leaders for health and enrichment of life seminars.

**Prayer Chain.** Pray on a daily basis for those in need. You will be provided with frequently updated information on prayer needs.



## SPECIAL TALENTS

**Foreign Language:** To translate or possibly teach a foreign language class.

**Culinary:** To assist in preparing, serving and cleaning up meals for various church functions on an "as needed" basis.

**Sewing:** To sew or mend costumes for plays, choir robes, etc.

**Knit/Crochet:** Join our Prayer Shawl Ministry in making lap blankets for those with illnesses, the elderly and those in need.
