Thirteen stations will be available for you to visit:

Traumatic Brain Injury: Ms. Ellen Leftwich, Horry County DSN Board, Head & Spinal Cord Injury Division, will present this information. A focus on sport-induced brain injuries will be featured.

Coastal Cancer Center: Ms. Angie Brinegar, Oncology Nurse Practitioner, will offer support measures for families dealing with cancer. Her topic: "Meet the Expert."

Glaucoma, Cataracts, Macular Degeneration: Dr. Thomas A. Whitaker, MD, FACS Board Certified Ophthalmologist, Eastern Carolina Regional Eye Center, will educate us on these topics.
