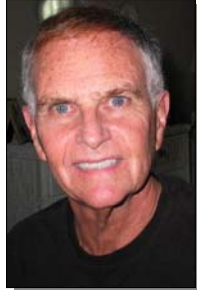

Dear Series Subscriber...



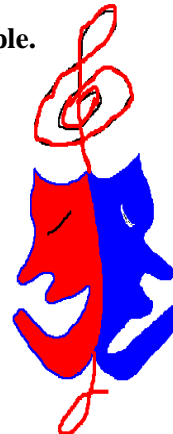
