The FPC Youth Committee is excited to present these two mission trip opportunities. We appreciate the support of Session which has enabled us to offer these trips at a reduced priced. The registration deposit of \$150** secures a spot on the mission team and is nonrefundable unless there is a student on the waiting list. Students on the waiting list are required to pay the \$150 registration deposit, but if a spot does not open on the trip for them, their registration deposit is refunded. Trips are limited: High school =26 students, 4 chaperones; Middle school = 20 students, 4 chaperones.
