Contract of Inurnment Rights

This Contract made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 20____, by and between First Presbyterian Church of Myrtle Beach herein referred to as the “Church” and _____ herein referred to as the “Purchaser”.

The Church has designated a place to serve as a repository of cremated human remains (Cremains) known as the Columbarium and has established the “Rules, Policies, and Regulations” (“Policy”) governing the use of the Columbarium. The Policy is attached hereto and made a part of this contract which shall be binding on the Purchaser and the Church.

In consideration of the preceding recitals, the mutual promises and covenants contained herein and other valuable consideration which are mutually agreed to by the Church and the Purchaser, the parties do agree as follows:

1. The Church agrees to provide to Purchaser and Purchaser agrees to purchase from the Church the right to use a niche in the Columbarium for the human cremains of one or two persons or an inscription on the Memorial Wall (“Wall”).
2. The Church agrees to have the niche cover or memorial wall inscribed as described in the Policy with the name, date of birth and date of death of the person(s) inurned therein and to provide for perpetual care.
3. The total purchase price shall be \$ _____ for a _____ niche/Wall payable upon the signing of this contract.
4. The Church shall retain full title to the Columbarium and grants to the Purchaser only the right to use the niche or memorial wall in the Columbarium in accordance with the Policy.
5. The Purchaser has read the Policy, is familiar with the contents, and agrees to be bound by the Policy. Purchaser further agrees to any future changes that may be made to the Policy.

6. The Purchaser authorizes the Church to relocate the Columbarium, his/her niche therein and the Cremains to another proper location should it become necessary for any reason, and this authorization shall be binding upon his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
7. The Purchaser agrees that no cause of action exists, or damages can be collected for any variation by the Church from the Policy.
8. The Purchaser shall have the right to use Niche # _____ or Memorial Wall # _____ as shown on the master diagram of the Columbarium on file in the office of First Presbyterian Church of Myrtle Beach.
